

Augustus Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot 2020 Cellers Augustus-Forum - 75 cl.

A classic in the Augustus range, the Cabernet-Sauvignon reaches new height each year. This "Mediterranean Bordeaux" is made with older vines yielding a much more 'serious' wine than 20 years ago.



Vinification

Selection of vine blocks. As these are close to the sea, the harvest often takes place a soon as the middle of August.



Storage potential

Drink as from : 2024
Best moment : 2024-2027
Until : 2029



To serve

Serve between 16 and 18°C, after decanting (at least during the first years).



Trial analysis

Nice red colour, from bright to dark. Ripe Bordeaux-style aromas - red fruit, leather, licorice, santal wood and a hint of cocoa. The first mouthfeel is a little austere, but then the round and juicy tannines soften the impression. Nice fruity finis

Description domain

Pioneers of the Penedès. Famous for their Chardonnay - one of Spain's very best. But their excellent vinegar is now more than half of their turnover.
