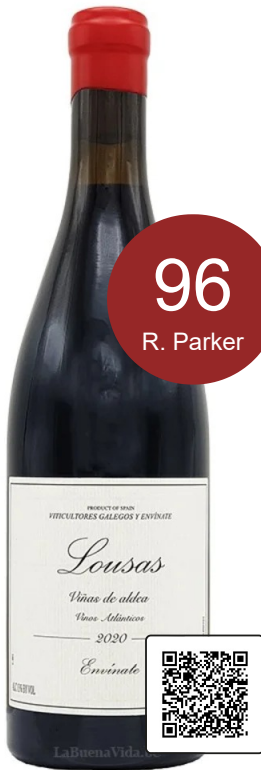


Lousas, viñas de Aldea 2023

Envínate - 75 cl.



Lousas is the workhorse of Envínate in Galicia. Their "village wine". Besides their top volcanic wines in Tenerife, they also have beautiful vineyards in Ribeira Sacra, located between 400 and 600 m altitude. The Lousas is the Spanish alternative to village wines from Burgundy, which today often cost many times as much as this Spaniard. All vineyards are in biodynamics.



Vinification

All vineyards are between 25 and 70 years old for this wine, from several small plots from different villages in Ribeira Sacra. Often very steep slopes, of both granite and slate. Very low yields of the different grape varieties planted interchangeably, as always in old vineyards. Mencía accounts for about 80% of the total blend. Depending on the year, between 70% and 100% is not destemmed. Maceration and fermentation on cement cuves followed by élevage on large wooden fouders. Non-interventionist, so no use of products nor sulphite during vinification, only before bottling. Maturation of about 10 to 14 months on these wooden fouders.

May be best decanted in its youth, as sometimes a bit reductive, depending on the moment. Pour in a Burgundy glass.



Trial analysis

Pale red in the glass, brilliance of red fruit. In the nose nice minerality with important vertical dimension, interwoven with pretty red fruit, woodland strawberries, red currant, blood orange and some violets. On the palate, racy. 2022 is a nice Atlantic year, unlike other regions in Spain. Accessible yet with nice complexity and length.

Description domain

Behind the name Envínate are four friends from various wine regions of Spain who met while studying at the Faculty of Oenology in Alicante. Their preference for fresh and drinkable wines from old local varieties make them close, and so they decided to create a common project - the name meaning something like "let you be winned". This project grew in parallel with the activities of consultancy of the four members at different estates. Envínate has been a prominent factor for change in the regions where it is active - those the four members are from, to wit, Tenerife, Murcia, Ribeira Sacra and Albacete.
