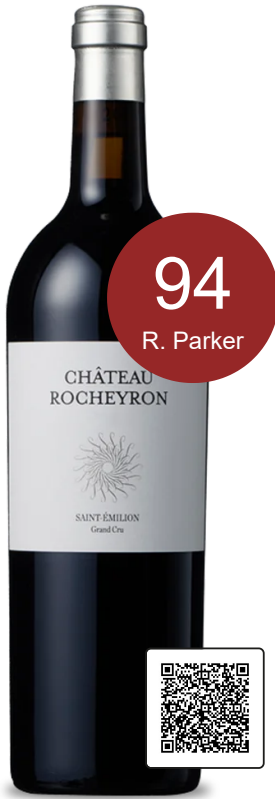


## Rocheyron, A.O.C. Saint Emilion Magnum 2019 Dominio de Pingus - 150 cl. (Magnum)

Rocheyron is the project of Peter Sisseck of Pingus and Swiss Silvio Denz. The vineyard is located on a limestone plateau near St Emilion.



### Vinification

Fermentation with temperature control in concrete cuves with regular remontages. Aged for 14 months in French barriques, 50% of which are new.



### Storage potential

Drink as from : 2024  
At its best between : 2030-2036  
Drink until : 2042



### To serve

18°C in a large glass. Decant for the first 5 years



### Trial analysis

Deep and youthful in colour. Rich and recognisable for this A.O.C. in terms of aromas. Slightly sun-drenched in which the expression of the Cabernet Franc shows up rather well. Monumental attack, powerful, silky tannins evident and subtle acidity for some freshness. Barrel ageing is perfectly absorbed by the fruit. Very long finish that feels free to unfold further. Density is at the level of Pingus.
