On par with the Bourgogne grands crus.
Very intense aromas of ripe fruit, sweet
spices and flowers. Fresh and crispy on the
palate, a meaty mouthfeel and a fruity, bone-
dry mentality in the finish. Lovely, juicy and
biting tannins, wrapped up in a nice woody
envelope.

Description domain

One grape: Mencia. One terroir: El Bierzo. One winemaker: Ricardo Pérez Palacios. The result is outstanding wines that speak of their origin. With Raul Perez, Ricardo realised the importance of his parcels' identity. They were the driving force behind the new regulations in the Bierzo appellation.
