To serve

Serve at cellar temperature, in a large bourgogne-glass after decanting.



Trial analysis

On par with the Bourgogne grands crus. Very intense aromas of ripe fruit, sweet spices and flowers. Fresh and crispy on the palate, a meaty mouthfeel and a fruity, bonedry mentality in the finish. Lovely, juicy and biting tannins, wrapped up in a nice woody envelope.
