

Mentidero 2020 Puro Rofe - 75 cl.

The freakiest of all the Rofe cuvées. A field blend with red and white grapes. Hence its colour, habitually like a clarete, but a little lighter this year, so it qualifies for a white. A wild wine!



Vinification

Direct pressing, 50% in oak vats, 50% in stainless steel tanks. Thus the red grapes are not de-stemmed. Spontaneous fermentation then some 6 months of ageing.



Storage potential

Drink preferably from 2022 and before 2030. At its best between 2025 and 2027.



> To serve

Decant before serving, so as to let its complex aromas express themselves. Serve at 14°C in a large glass.



Trial analysis

Logically, this is the darkest of all blends, because it contains some Listán Negro grapes. Very complex on the nose, full ofd herbs but also red fruit, fennel, aniseed and even flowers after some swirling. Complex and mineral on the palate, with a dry, salty finsih. Very nice!
