Pazo Señorans - 50 cl.

An entry-level wine... and a top wine! Respectful of its terroir, elegant and complex. And with some ageing potential. Pazo means estate in Galician.



Vinification

The grapes are picked manually in the pergola vineyards. Vinification takes place in inox cuves at a cool temperature followed by a five-month maturation of the yeast cells.



Storage potential

Drink as from : 2024
Best moment : 2025-2027
Until : 2029



To serve

Serve at 12°C, preferably decanted (at least during the first 3 years after bottling).



Trial analysis

Pale golden colour. Subtly mineral on the nose, with hints of Granny Smith apple and flintstone, litchi, papaya. A very rich and complex aromatic pallet. Charming and fruity on the palate, but also dry, dense, and with a strong backbone of crisp acidity. Albariño at its best!

Description domain

One the nicest estates in the DO Rias Baixas, and one of the best Albariño wines, Pazo de Señorans was instrumental in founding the DO Rias Baixas. Here, the quality level is very high indeed.
