

Corimbo I, Magnum 2016 Bodegas La Horra (Roda) - 150 cl. (Magnum)

The name of Corimbo is a token of rarity in itself, since it is a rare kind of thistle. Production: 20,000 bottles.



Vinification

Aged for 14 months in French (80%) and American oak barrels, 1/3 of which are new. Production: 20,000 bottles.



Storage potential

Drink as from : 2022
Best moment : 2028-2031

To serve

18°C in a large glass, after decanting, at least in the first years.



Trial analysis

Deep red colour. Owing to its density, the wine should get some air. Then, it will reveal nice young aromas (blackberries, spices), but not a hint of wood. A juicy, impressively potent wine on the palate. Full-bodied like a Ribera, but with the Roda trademark.

Description domain

A new top wine estate in Ribera del Duero. This small scale project was built around some old vines by Roda team, of Rioja fame. The quality requirements are as high as in Rioja.
