Traditional vinification in stainless steel tank. The various grapes are harvested at different moments and blended later. Maceration, alcoholic and malolactic fermentation in stainless steel also. Then the wine stays 8 more months in the same tanks before being bottled.

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Trial analysis Pale colour. Reduction notes on the nose which disappear when the wine is given some air, then mineral and salty notes, with a hint pf white fruit and flint. Very mineral on the palate too, with a nice crisp acidity. Not for beginners!

That was also the impression of Rayco Fernandez, a distributor on the neighbouring island of Gran Canaria. So with the help of some friends of the same mind, he set out to make real terroir wines on Lanzarote. And the fact that we, after 25 years of tasting wines from all regions of Spain, have still been impressed by their production shows how good these extreme terroir wines can be.
