

Coma Vella 2018 Mas d'en Gil - 75 cl.



Coma Vella is the first level of this estate's high end range. Are you looking for a super Priorat wine at a very good price-quality relation ? Here it is! Seductive, typically Mediterranean, fruit but lively. This cuvée comes mainly from old vines of Grenache and Carignan. Coma Vella means old valley.



Vinification

Aged for 10 months in French oak barrels (10% new, 90% 2nd year). 10% of the blend goes into 3,000 litre vats.



Storage potential

Drink as from: 2024
Best moment: 2025-2029
Until: 2031



To serve

Serve at cellar temperature, in a large glass, preferably after decanting, at least during the 5 first years.



Trial analysis

Deep red colour. Complex aromatic pallet of Mediterranean spices, red and black fruit (blackberries, raspberries), and a hint of vanilla, a touch of coffee and cocoa. The fruit stays on the palate, accompanied by nice tannins and some acidity. Very long and mineral finish.

Description domain

One of the largest - and best - estates in Priorat, Mas d'en Gil was saved from decay by the Rovira Family at the end of the 1990's. It is now back at the top with superb wines which both respect the local traditions in terms of viticulture and winemaking.
