

Verdello Antiguo 2021 Quinta da Muradella - 75 cl.

With this wine, José Luis Mateo has accomplished a tour de force and a première, recuperating the Verdello Antiguo, an old clone of Godello from the Monterrei heights. This wine has more tension than your usual Godello.



Vinification

Indigenous yeasts only. The grapes are pressed in whole bunches, then fermented in 500 litre barrels where the wine stays one its lees. Then it finished its ageing in stainless steel, still on its lees.

Trial analysis

The vines grow in sandy soils and slate. Hence the delicacy of the sand and the minerality of the slate which show in the wine. A lot of complexity on the palate, full of nuances with mineral notes in the background. A long finish. A lot of potential.

Description domain

A modest man, José Luis Mateo is yet considered by many as the only real good winemaker in the Monterrei appellation, and even the best of all Galicia. He doesn't care about the accolades and scores he gets in the international wine press, working according to what he sees in his vines.
