

La Provincia 2020 Prieto Pariente - 75 cl.

This is Ignacio's and Martina's entry level wine, made with grapes from several villages of the Valladolid Province (hence the name): Mucientes, Valbuena de Duero and Pedrosa del Rey. Old vines from the 1940's.



Vinification

Spontaneous fermentation with natural wild yeasts, at controlled temperature. Part of the wine gets its malolactic fermentation in stainless steel tanks, another part in wooden vats. The wine is aged in 250 and 500 litre barrels.



Storage potential

Drink as from: 2023
Best moment: 2024-2026
Until 2029



To serve

Decant to give the wine some air.



Trial analysis

Nice bright red colour. Red fruit (raspberries) on the nose, with a hint of vanilla from the ageing in wood. Good acidity. A well-structured wine, wide and long on the palate. A lot of fruit.

Description domain

This is the estate of Ignacio and Martina Pariente, son and daughter of Marivi Pariente, from the renowned José Pariente estate in Rueda, which produces one of Spain's most popular and famous white wine. Martina and Ignacio wanted to give a new lease of life to old, forgotten parcels in Castilla-León, in red and in white. After years of exploration, they have assembled a nice portfolio of tiny old parcels of vines which produce very expressive wines.
