

José Pariente, A Vilerma 2023 José Pariente - 75 cl.

This is one of the historic domains of the Ribeiro region. Located in the Valle de Avia in the beautiful green interior of Galicia. Arsenio Paz was the founder and inspirer of the estate since 1977. In 2022, José Pariente decided to take over this small boutique winery as Arsenio had no successor. This is a small 6ha estate with a good 20,000 bottles of production. José Pariente's main aim is to continue Arsenio's legacy with respect for the region and terroir.



Vinification

The grapes are hand-picked and then vinified in 500-litre cuves inox and foudres. Yeast cells are worked with to give the wine sufficient body. The terroir here is mainly granite with some clay/loam deposits here and there and lots of boulders and rocks.

Serve at 12°C, in a large glass.



Trial analysis

Lovely bright colour. In the nose an Atlantic fresh attack with mainly notes of bay leaf and fennel, interspersed with some zesty fruit and citrus. On the palate, nice filling with brilliant acidity and notes of apple, melon and pome fruit. On the side always salty hints, so the wine goes very well with the typical dishes of the Ribeiro region: seafood and fish.
